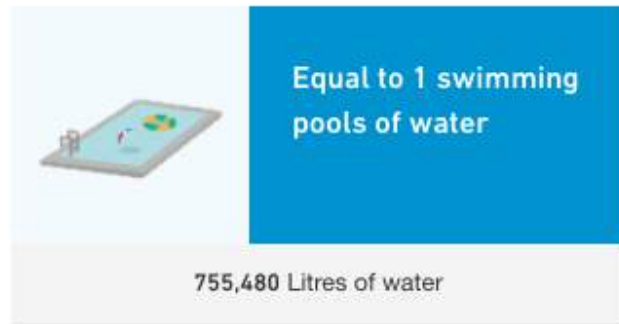
How are CERES Outreach doing?

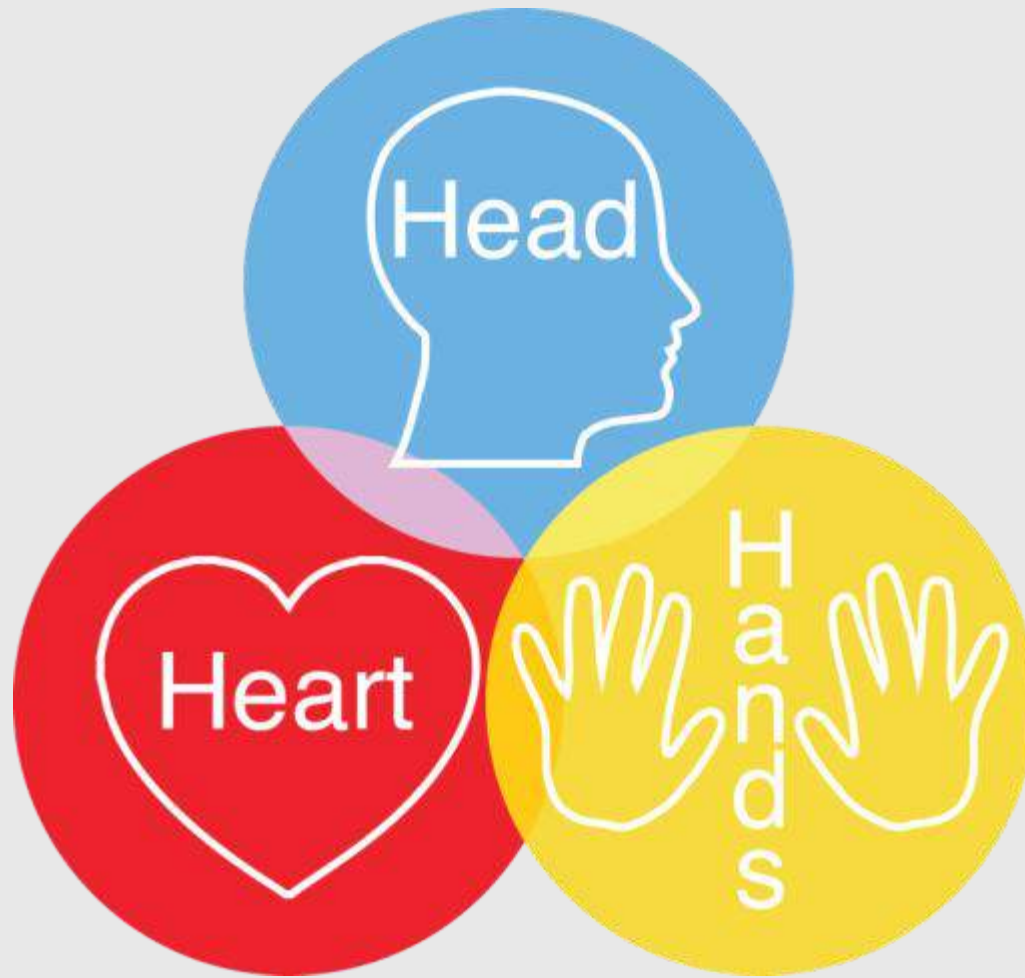

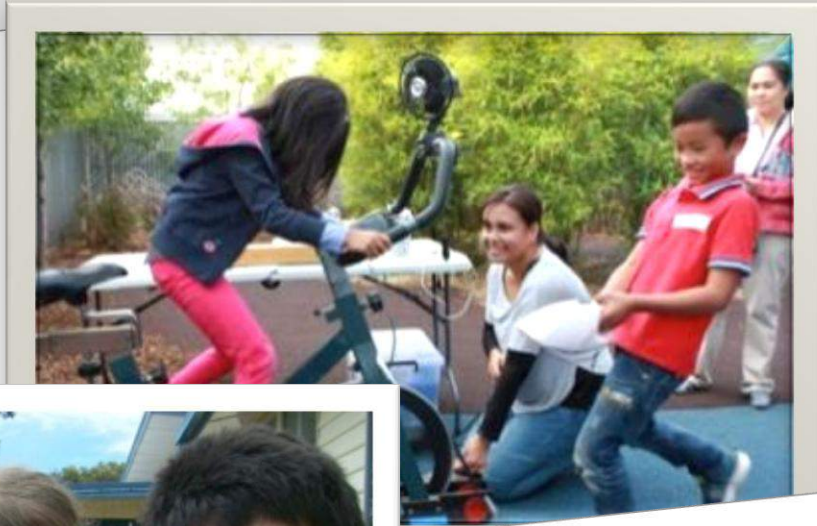
