Waste & Litter

Incursions - Free 30 - 45 minute incursions are available to eligible schools with topics of:

❖ Waste and Recycling

Students will learn what happens to their waste from the moment each bin is collected, whether it goes to a landfill or a recycling facility. We'll cover what items can be recycled and why it is important to recycle. They'll also learn about the 3 R's - Reduce, reuse and recycle and identifying opportunities at school and at home to implement these steps.

Organics: Food Waste to Compost & Worms farms

Organics such as food waste from schools, households, restaurants and hospitals make up a large proportion of the waste sent to landfill. During this incursion students will learn of the negative impacts of landfilling organics and ways to minimise food waste. They'll also learn about the difference between worm farming and composting and will have the opportunity to get their hands dirty recycling organic waste into a valuable resource that is perfect for your garden.



❖ Litter

What is litter and where does it end up? Students will discuss the origins of litter and its effects on our local and natural environment. They will make connections between reduced litter and healthier waterways and oceans. Students will then access their school grounds, identifying problem litter hotspots and brainstorming actions to reduce this.

Baseline Waste Audits – A baseline waste audit will assess one days' worth of waste from your school to help you plan waste reduction / prevention activities.

Grade 3 to Year 10 – CERES Mobile Energy Classroom

CERES Education has transformed a retired ambulance, previously used to save lives, into a vehicle now used to save the planet, and they are taking to the road in the Mobile Energy Classroom!



This interactive learning experience offers an alternative classroom, demonstrating future energy solutions to students across Victoria. Sessions will explore renewable energy technologies as students generate their own energy, see solar panels making electricity to power common appliances and learn how to be part of the solution.

Prep to Grade 2 – Power Rangers - by CERES

Free 45 minute Power Ranger incursion to help support your schools energy program. Students explore the different forms of energy, how they are created and explore ways it can be conserved around the home and at school.
